Celestia Awards was birthed out of a desire to celebrate and elevate Liberian Gospel Music — to not only honor our legends, but to also spotlight rising stars and encourage unity, excellence, and purpose within the industry. We are pleased to announce that nominations for the 2025 edition will officially open on **September 1, 2025**, and run through **September 15, 2025**. Voting runs from **October 1 – 30**, 2025. The voting process will follow a **hybrid system**, comprising **70% public votes** and **30% input from a carefully selected vetting committee** made up of industry professionals, spiritual leaders, and music experts. This new system is designed to ensure fairness, credibility, and a balanced reflection of both public interest and artistic merit.
